Franz Xaver BERGMAN (1861-1936). In the manner of. Polygonal onyx dish with a circular receptacle, surmounted by a bronze subject with polychrome patina depicting a titmouse. Vienna. 20th century. H_7 cm L_12 cm D_9 cm Wear to the polychromy, chips to the onyx. Viennese art bronzes from the early 20th century are distinguished by their careful naturalistic production, often enhanced with cold-painted vivid colors, depicting animals either draped or represented in their natural attitude. This piece aligns with the taste for the productions of Franz Xaver Bergman, the celebrated Viennese founder renowned for his finely detailed and vividly colored animal subjects combined with hardstone or marble bases.
