-Faithful to the tradition of Aubusson greenery, this tapestry shows us undergrowth in a verdant landscape.

-The foreground is governed by a tree in full bloom that occupies the entire height in which blends in its center, a perched parrot with outstretched wings. To the left of this tree a dog observes the viewer.

-The borders are carefully composed and decorated with garlands of plants and fruits. The right side border seems to be added.
