**GUSTAVE BOULANGER** (Paris 1824-1888) Roman Slave Boy 1886 Black chalk on tracing paper stuck down on thicker paper 30 × 12 cm Stamp in red ink, lower right, from the Boulanger sale which takes the form of a facsimile of the signature of the artist Provenance: Boulanger Sale, Hôtel Drouot, March 14-16, 1889 This drawing is the study on tracing paper by Gustave Boulanger for his figure of a slave boy in the painting *The Roman Slave Market* which he exhibited at the Salon of 1886. If you look at Marie-Madeleine Aubrun's publication on Boulanger (1986) you will see that Boulanger made a drawing on tracing paper exactly like this for many of his important figures.
