family of Marseille fishermen, has expressed a
deep feeling in this painting about the Old Port of
Marseille and the lives of the local fishers.In the

Arnaud-Durbec, edited by his nephew, Albert
Arnaud, the painting is described as:331. Marine.
Sun setting, on the left the fort / St Jean, on the
