Very large bronze titled the immortal triumph or pegasus accompanying a victorious athlete. dating from the end of the 19th century, it rests on a beautiful base in original sea green marble. a cartouche on the terrace indicates the name of this bronze and its authors: L.Moreau and Scotte. it is also signed on the sphere. it is a very slender and elaborate large-scale bronze with a beautiful movement. Pegasus the winged horse is rearing up on its front legs resting on the sphere representing the world and on which flies a bird of prey. near Pegasus a handsome athlete holds his reins, stretching out his arm at the end of which he holds two laurel wreaths as a sign of victory. this bronze is magnificent and the details are superb: look at the look of Pegasus, the feathers
