Large 19th century Paris porcelain vase with floral decoration 1st Restoration period typically in the style of Jacob Petit Hand-painted porcelain with a bouquet of flowers Base in the shape of a Louis XV style pedestal decorated with scrolls and underlined with a gold thread The vase is supported by 4 winding feet going up along the vase in a decor of acanthus leaves underlined with a very fine gold net 2 sides are decorated with bouquets of very finely executed polychrome spring flowers and the other 2 sides are decorated with foliage underlined with golden fillets The 4-lobed neck is in the shape of draperies of the most beautiful effect Mark underneath with a brush to decipher Very good general condition but to report a cooking crack on the base of about 2 cm and a slight scratch on the
