remarkably hallmarked (base, "bell" and inside
binet) with the Hallmarks of Charge (a crowned
A on the side) and Discharge (crowned martlet)
of the Jurisdiction of PARIS 1726-32, the
Hallmarks of Jurande for PARIS 1729 (N
Crowned) and the Hallmarks of the Master
Goldsmith Nicolas GREBEUDE (crowned Fleur
de Lys, two grains, his initials "NG" and a vase)
received in 1706. Extremely Rare Pair of
Candlesticks from the early 18th century in very
good general condition and remarkably punched,
