Tsuba in cut and chiseled iron, details inlaid in solid gold. The characters are excessively in relief, thickness of the tsuba 4.8 mm and 9.6 mm for the characters. Diameter: 76mm. Decor representing Jo and Uba with their broom and rake under a fir tree. It refers to the legend of 2 lovers who, united for life, were very happy and together became very old. They died the same day at the same time. Their spirit lives in 2 old pines, one in Sumi-Yoshi and one on Taka-Sago beach; on full moon nights, their spirits reincarnate on this beach and they sweep the pine needles. Symbol of eternal marital happiness. Edo period of Japan. 19th century or before.
