Beautiful hand-woven tapestry by Paul Cosandier, painter, pupil of Fernand Leger and Jean Lurcat. He produced several tapestry cartoons for the Raymond Picaud workshop, recognized as one of the best weavers of the 1960s. Grace is its decoration entrusted by Abbé Devémy to the greatest masters of the first half of the 20th century. As a result, the humble mountain church became a veritable manifesto of the artistic movements of that time, marking a revival of sacred art. the abbot contacts, thanks to his friend the father Couturier, the most important artists of the time, who all agree to collaborate in the project with enthusiasm. Among these, Georges Rouault, Pierre Bonnard, Fernand Léger, Jean Lurçat and Paul Cosandier,
