Description

Large Regency style mirror in carved solid oak. The scalloped shape of the mirror is totally in the style of the Regency, rich sculpture of flowers, foliage and masks in cartouches in the upper and lower part. On the sides of the figures in caryatids with a fleurdelysée headdress. The ice is original, parquet flooring at the back. The dimensions make it a very decorative mirror with a beautiful presence that stands out from all the gilded mirrors found in general. This frame is originally assembled with large bolts (most certainly to be able to be disassembled during travel), a few splits in the wood. Period late 19th century around 1890-1900. Flat delivery in wooden crate on pallet by carrier on the ground floor, 250 euros in France, 600 euros in the EU and 1500 euros rest of the world.
