Set comprising a lot of 4 CLYPENAS TEROIDA OR SAND DOLLAR DES SABLES family of CLYPEASTER SUBDEPRESSUS This small creature is a very fragile member of the ECHINODERMES family (sea urchin, starfish), with a flattened and circular shell decorated with a star and holes arranged in rays. It is a veritable natural pentacle which contains in its structure and its designs the rules of the golden ratio and the divine proportion: esoteric symbols worthy of all interpretations. A Christian legend attributes to this shell to contain the life and death of Christ. Dimensions: diameter 10.5 cms - 7 cms - 7.5 cms - 6.5 cms Lot of 6 white ACROPORA corals from the ACROPORIDAE family Builder corals that participate in the creation of coral reefs, whose shape can be of the branching type ,

rustling or tubular. Acropora corals feed at night by spreading their tentacles to catch zooplankton. They live in clear, shallow water. Dimensions: 18 X 11 cms - 14 X 13 cms - diameter 10 - and diameter 11 Set of 2 FUNGIA PAUMOTENSIS - Indo Pacific Corals of the FUNGIIDAE family. Genus of SCLERACTINIARIES in resemblance to terrestrial fungi whose Fungia are natural and each one is unique. Despite the solidity of their skeleton, their evolutionary history is poorly known and they are thought to have appeared in the Cretaceous.
