On the front, a wooden element with an inverted butt is sculpted in relief, with recess, scrolls and flowers. At the back, a mahogany element forming a ramp is composed of turned spindles, the top of which forms an upholstered cord. The set rests on four turned feet ending on wheels. Ideal in your living room or bedroom, this daybed, synonymous with relaxation and comfort, will give your decor a timeless charm.
