Rare glazed earthenware plate by Roger Capron in Vallauris, 1958. Decoration of a polychrome sunflower on a speckled orange background. Perfect condition Diameter 24.3cm Signed on the reverse with a Capron Vallauris cartouche and the letter T. CAPRON Roger (1922-2006) Professor of Applied Arts, Capron was first interested in drawing. He discovered ceramic work in Vallauris before Picasso, and created the Callis workshop with Robert Picault. He founded his own workshop in 1952 and sold his collections, particularly in the United States, to the Saks Fifth Avenue department store. He received awards in numerous international exhibitions in Milan, Brussels, Cannes... From
