Very beautiful composition reminiscent of the great painter Chardin. Signed lower left, in very good condition! In his juice ! Rousseau was a pupil of the grand master Antoine Jean Gros and of Jean Victor Bertin. And received the gold medal in 1848 at the Salon of French Artists. Format of this unframed canvas: 41 x 33.5 cm.
