Below, a central door benefits from a rosewood veneer arranged in an open book underlined with a stained wood fillet. This door is embellished with an original lock in perfect working order and a chiselled entrance. Two large open spaces are present on each side. The solid amaranth legs have wide grooves and end in a ball. A carefully restored piece of furniture that will seduce you with its unusual lines and ornamentation. ***** Period: 1930
