A sign that the painting was well preserved before. The dimensions are perfect for adorning a country dining room. The price allows amateurs to acquire a painting close to those of Christophe Huet (uncle of the very famous Jean-Baptiste Huet) whose rare paintings on the market have 6-figure prices.
