Beautiful Afghan in wool on wool, measuring 245 cm wide by 325 cm long in superb condition from the 1970s-80s. In red and black wool, for the whole, this rug is decorated with 28 large guls, medallions found on Central Asian rugs, here alternating with small crosses. # Nice deep high quality wool and nice classic fade on these rugs. # Note the quality of the intricate border design. Afghan handicrafts are always very good bills. In other regions, nomadic rugs are often loosely knotted and have long pile, unlike Afghan or Turkmen rugs which have dense and tight knots due to the Persian knot, velvet strokes and goat's or sheep's hair. sheep's wool, supple and shiny. But the use of goat hair is more common for warp and weft. These carpets have a masculine aura and have always been appreciated
