Description

Beautiful oval design for this table with curved legs. in walnut. The top of the feet carved with a group of flowers, the base of the foot finished with a leaf resting on the volute of the snail foot, the belt is molded and carved in the center of each side with a group of flowers, the tray is molded in corbin beak. The table opens in the middle and reveals a system of oak slides, in very good condition, with a retractable support base, to be used when inserting several extensions. The table has its 5 original service extensions, which can be used individually or grouped, they are made of solid wood, assembled by a socket, small tenons allow the extension to be locked on the previous one and gives the whole a great stability, the side edges of the extensions have the same molding as the top. In the center of the sliding

system under the top, Maison Krieger Paris
Faubourg Saint Antoine marking. Very good state

The Krieger workshops were founded in Paris in
1826 by Antoine Krieger (1804-1869) and
Nicolas Krieger, and will be active until the
1930s.

The Krieger house initially produces secret
furniture with sophisticated mechanisms, it will
specialise in replicas of pieces with prestigious
origins inspired by the cabinetmakers Rieserner
and Cressent, and will be renowned for its
furniture productions in the styles of the 18th
century, including Louis XV, Louis XVI, and
Directoire.
