He will frequent contemporaries of his time such as Alphonse Daudet, Guy de Maupassant, Victor Hugo or Paul Verlaine. In the 1920s, he also created gardens during his stays in the Mediterranean, notably for Empress Eugénie's Villa Cyrnos. In 1913, he will be named Chevalier of the Legion of Honor.
