Avignon, Joseph Hurard exhibited at the Salon des Indépendants from 1908 to 1914 many landscapes, notably of Avignon and Villeneuve-les-Avignon. He joined the Group of Thirteen founded by Clément Brun.

After the First World War, he exhibited in galleries in Marseille.

In 1932, he settled in Martigues. site he has been painting since 1913.
