In biblical scenes, her inventive fantasy is manifested with the greatest attention to detail in the ornamental and poetic details. The artist's sensitivity is always one of the major elements that emerges first from the work; dream and reality then mingle in this world of wonder, where we discover the poetry of animals, the grandiose sites of a magical land. The elements of a landscape are from another universe through the eyes of the artist and it is a true fairy tale that MADY tells us in her work. Mady de La Giraudière, born in Toulouse on April 3, 1922, spent her childhood in the freedom of nature in LAVELANET in Ariège. She is appreciated as a visionary of a pure and poetic world and her painting is a visualization that encompasses all aspects of everyday life. Mady de La GIRAUDIÈRE is a self-taught artist who works by instinct, letting her heart and great sensitivity speak. She asserts her personality through her art of storytelling.
