He then follows the courses of Ilya Repin at the Academy of Saint-Petersburg. He will be successively symbolist and impressionist. His activity as a painter was doubled, from 1910, by that of decorator at the Moscow theatre. Lived in France and Belgium (1923-1937). Lives in
