Portrait of a child, oil on canvas by François Furet, renowned Swiss painter born in Geneva in 1842 and died in the same city in 1919.

Signed lower right.

François Francis Furet, of French origin, has spent his entire artistic career in Geneva. Pupil of Barthélémy Menn, he devoted himself to landscape and decorative painting; he is the author of a large panorama of the Swiss Alps. François Furet is a member of "Emules" (Auguste Baud-Bovy, Edmond Ravel, Hugues Bovy, Léon Gaud).

Medal at the Universal Exhibition in Paris in 1889, Legion of Honor in 1896.

Exhibits frequently in Geneva (1861-1898).
