Period 1st half XIX Dimensions: HXLXP = 27 x 28 x 12 cm WHAT WE THINK: these wall lights are of very good quality. They come from a mansion in the 8th arrondissement. They work perfectly. DID YOU KNOW?: Fame is originally an allegorical Greek deity personifying the character of public or social recognition. With the Romans, the deity lost its monstrous appearance for that of a winged woman often represented with a trunk. It is this form that was taken up by many artists from the Middle Ages.
