A living room table that is out of the ordinary.
it is a flying table with all-face decoration finely worked and sculpted in blond oak.

a work from Liège from the 19th century.

this table has a beautiful rectangular blond oak top flanked by spandrels at each corner.

the top rests on finely worked scalloped crosspieces decorated with floral motifs and acanthus leaves, the edge of which is hemmed with moldings over the entire length.

the set rests on 4 doe feet ending in hooves, simulating ungulate feet and whose upper part is connected to the crosspieces by a very pretty decoration of finely carved acanthus leaves.

is still fully pegged.

Very stable thanks to its flared base, it can support considerable weight.

she was given a treatment with xylophene for prevention but she was not attacked by xylophagous insects.

the oak is very beautiful with a fine mesh and a blond walnut-colored patina, a waxed and lustrous patina without any varnish.

the proportions are charming and as it is worked on each side you can place it in the center of the room.

it remains handy and light.

it can be likened to a hunting table thanks to its ungulate feet.

a small angle on one of the spandrels of the top has been restored.

a very beautiful coffee table, unusual it is very decorative.
