Description

This mid-17th century walnut sideboard opens with four doors and two drawers, a diamond marquetry pattern is inlaid in the center of the door panels and at each end of the drawers, richly molded and decorated with flat strip panels, this sideboard with retain its original cornices and feet. The upper cornice, under which is carved a frieze of leaves, has an architectural pediment, the central part includes a small niche which must have housed a statuette. Its locks and keys as well as the carved wrought iron entrances are original. This piece of furniture has undergone some small restorations in the past and a few pieces of wood have been made, the panels have dried and are no longer very joined, the upper board which covered the top of the piece of furniture has been replaced by a chipboard (this part is not visible).
