Description

This marmoreal glass vase, blown, with a long stretched neck is representative of the production of André Delatte, a major figure in the School of Nancy.

Derived from Persian bottles of the 7th and 8th centuries, Daum produced this type of vase and called them "Berluze", André Delatte: "Galinette" in homage to Emile Gallé.

With a very current orange color, this copy is in excellent original condition.

It measures 42.5 cm high and 12.5 x 10 cm at the widest of the base.
