Enamel plate made after the Second World War, by the monks of the Abbey of Saint Martin de Ligugé, in a gilded wooden frame. "God the Father and Tetramorph from the Greek tetra, four and morphé, form Representation of the four evangelists in their allegorical forms, (the man for Saint Matthew, the eagle for Saint John, the bull for Saint Luke and the lion for Saint Mark This representation is inspired by the vision of Ezekiel and by the description of the four living beings of the Apocalypse according to Saint John.
