Spelter with green and brown patina, titled "Faucheuse", titled and signed on the embankment by the French sculptor AJ Scotte (1867-1925). The work "Faucheuse" represents a young woman dressed in a long dress, her hair tied in a scarf, leaning on her scythe. This former farmer works in the fields during the wheat harvest. This subject rests on a circular base in molded wood. This spelter, which illustrates the work of yesteryear, will please with its authenticity and the contrast of its patinas.
