Description

Large miniature on ivory representing a young woman leaning against a balustrade. She wears a suit with a green velvet surcoat edged with ermine and a white dress. The description of the costume highlights the demi-parure composed of a gold and emerald bodice jewel and a gold and emerald tiara decorated with fleurons. It leans on a balustrade decorated with neo-Gothic motifs representing Gothic arcades and finials opening onto a garden. Golden brass frame. With Romanticism, a return to the style of the Middle Ages or neo-Gothic style developed. The neo-Gothic style affects all the arts including literature with the publication of Notre-Dame de Paris by V. Hugo and the Tour de Nesle by A. Dumas. In France, it was the Duchess of Berry who was the instigator of the cathedral style
