Pietro Annigoni (Milan, 1910- Florence, 1988) In 1925 he moved with his family to Florence, where he attended the Accademia di Belle Arti. In 1930 he exhibited his works for the first time in a group show and in 1932 he held his first solo exhibition. Four years later he also exhibited in Milan, gaining widespread acclaim. Specialising in portraiture, he painted faces of important personalities, including Elizabeth II, Pope John
