Important subject in carved beech dating from the end of the 19th century. This work depicts a Breton woman dressed in traditional clothes, consisting of a long dress, a doily, shoulder pads, a headdress from the country of Carhaix-Plouguer and is shod in wooden clogs. This bigoudène, on her return from the market, holds a duck in her right hand and under her left arm a wicker basket filled with fruit or vegetables. This beech sculpture, crafted with precision, will delight lovers of Brittany and lovers of works of art.
