Maurice Journès had an artistic training as a sculptor in Grenoble and Paris. In 1863 he became head of a school of drawing and modeling in Bagnères-de-Bigorre, a town a little south of Tarbes in the Hautes-Pyrénées, where he was the founder of an important school of Bigourdan sculptors. He left Bagnères in 1870 to
