MURATON Alphonse Born in 1824 in Tours (Indre-et-Loire). Died December 23, 1911 at Source-Maré (near Ménars, Loir-et-Cher). Nineteenth century. French.

Painter of religious subjects, genre scenes, portraits, pastel artists.

He is the husband of Euphémie Muraton. He was a pupil of the School of Drawing of Tours, then of Michel Drolling. He exhibited at the Paris Salon where he won a medal in 1868.
