Pair of gilt bronze candlesticks from the Napoleon III period dating from the mid-19th century. These old torches, now electrified, feature large sculptures of angels holding fruit tree branches in their hands. Each cherub rests on a pedestal decorated with leaves, scrolls, ram's heads and adorned with portraits of cherubs in Sèvres porcelain. These lights are mounted on four feet tops, adjustable in height, meticulously crafted. This charming pair of candlesticks will add a delicate touch to your interior decoration.
