Ntshak or dance loincloth with red background, Kuba ethnic group, Congo or Zaire, early 20th century.

The Ntshak symbolizes a social recognition of the one who wears it to see is offered as a sign of recognition to a deceased thus respecting the link with the ancestors. Made of raffia and other vegetable fibres, embroidered and with applied motifs, dyed with padauk red.
