conservation of each painting is excellent. Painter from Salon, from the Provençal School, who lived in Salon-de-Provence, rue Auguste Moutin. In 1913, the municipality of Salon entrusted him with the restoration of the hall of honor of the Cercle des Arts et des Lettres (1842), rue des Spinners of silk. He participated, as a draftsman, in the illustration of the book by Jean Blanchard: History of Salon from the origins to our days, Salon, 1935, who was president of the "Comité du Vieux-Salon" and Curator of the museum of the same name (closed in 1967), located in the castle of Empéri. From 1929 to 1936, he exhibited gouaches at the SAF ("Small birds" in 1929, "Coin d'atelier" in 1936) At the end of 1937, a "Désiré Girard Exhibition" took place in Aix-en-Provence , at the Friends of the Arts gallery
