landscapes of Provence and the Riviera. He occupies a workshop close to the painter François Nardi on the quay of the Party in Toulon.

Paul Levéré was appointed as a member of the Fine Arts Commission of the City of Toulon and then of the theatrical commission.

He then became a professor at the School of Fine Arts in the city of Toulon.

He took part in local exhibitions from 1910, presenting landscapes from the South of France.

In 1924, he was appointed painter to the Navy.

He collaborates with the artistic magazine "La Provence illustrées".
