known about the life of Georges Feldkirchner. He
was born in America in 1885, but moved to Paris,
where he had a studio in Montmartre. He worked
as a painter, book illustrator and sculptor, but he
is best known for his studies of wild animals,
done at Cirque Amar and Cirque Pinder from the
late 1920s to the late 1940s. Cirque Amar had
was founded in Algeria in the 1860s and spawned
