China has a long and remarkable artistic tradition of carpet production, dating back to the 15th century. Originally, the designs and patterns were inspired by Chinese culture: porcelain, landscapes, majestic dragons, religious symbols...

The designs of Chinese rugs are usually cut in relief, giving them their famous three-dimensional appearance.

Made of soft wool, Chinese carpets have a rather thick and dense pile. Very robust, they are nonetheless very soft.
