Theme: the 3 Dutch gin drinkers Henri Cassiers, born August 11, 1858 in Antwerp and died February 27, 1944 in Brussels (Ixelles), was a Belgian illustrator and poster designer. An architect by training, Henri Cassiers began to paint at the free academy "La Patte de Dindon" (on the Grand-Place in Brussels), then at the Royal Academy of Fine Arts in Antwerp (professor Henry Stacquet), and at the Brussels and Saint-Josse-ten-Noode academies. Painter, watercolourist and gouachist, lithographer and etcher, he is best known for his commercial posters, created for shipping companies and seaside resorts on the North Sea
