In solid silver, well hallmarked, it is decorated in chasing with flower motifs and garlands of grapes, the underside with a ribbed border. Wide rim to prevent wine from spilling out. The rolling snake, as usual, serving as a handle.

title, and maker's mark "TM" and crescent moon.
French working dating from the first part of the
19th century, between 1819 and 1838..probably
