Clément Gontier, (1876-1918) French School He studied painting at the School of Fine Arts in Toulouse, before joining Jean-Paul Laurens' studio in Paris.

From 1895, he participated in the Salon of French artists. In 1900, he took lessons from the painter Benjamin Constant. Clément Gontier had his first
