Charles X tripod pedestal table in marquetry decorated with Saint Michael slaying the dragon Italy origin probably from Sorrento Superb pedestal table in solid wood and veneered with a very beautiful marquetry work In the center of the top: Saint Michael on his horse slaying the dragon All surrounded many geometric friezes Interesting shaft with different woods such as walnut, olive... Edges of the foot with marquetry in the shape of palmettes Under the top, cabinetmaker's label: Siméoni Amilcare Perimeter of the inlaid top Some slight traces of time which give charm to the whole Superb Italian work This pedestal table can be dismantled in 2 parts The top is fixed to the barrel with a large internal screw h: 75 cm width: 49.9 cm long: 50.5 cm
