## Description

Very beautiful lithograph illustrating the Voyage de La Pérouse, produced by Henri Da Ros in the 60s/70s, TL 20/270 ex. Under frame "Henri Da Ros entered the art publishing business in 1972, illustrating "Le Voyage de Laperouse ". Confronted then to illustrate an edition of the "Essais de Montaigne", in four volumes, the artist, "laborious and indefatigable" managed to seduce the elitist world of bibliophiles by producing one of the best interpretations of the genre. With the "Contes de Voltaire", new edition in four volumes, we discovered a Da Ros full of humor and elegance. The artist proved to be a virtuoso, capable of soaking up a text with such precision that one can that Voltaire himself would have smiled when discovering his characters. Just as in Montesquieu's "L'Esprit des Lois", Da Ros's
