Beautiful lamp in immaculate condition, Atossa model by Lalique France, amber color (most popular color). Created by Marie-Claude Lalique in 1972. The collaboration between father and daughter is a recurring pattern in the Lalique family; Like Suzanne and René, Marie-Claude collaborates with her father Marc son of the famous glassmaker. Imbued with the family tradition, she is committed to continuing the work of her grandfather and her father. Like them, she draws her inspiration from nature. René's influence is also found in his taste for color. Indeed, it regularly associates colored crystal with clear crystal. This piece offers us an example with the amber flower pattern applied to the colorless body. He also happens to decline his works in different colors. Small anecdote: the hedge vetch
