Rare bronze fountain project of neoclassical inspiration representing the allegory of a river dating from the first half of the 19th century. a very finely detailed and chiseled lead and bronze model.

it would seem that the two characters of ancient inspiration represent a river god accompanied by Ceres the goddess of harvests above a pottery from which flows a source symbolizing a river. a fountain model, a rather rare preliminary project to meet and of very good quality of execution. take a good look at the details: the superb realization of the faces, the crowns of flowers, the drapes etc...

a beautifully crafted neoclassical lead sculpture.
