The painting is accompanied by the know-how of Professor Giancarlo Sestieri, expert and author of books on Italian battles. He made his debut in the circle of Marco Ricci, where he learned the vigorous contrasts of chiaroscuro that characterized his early works. Then, he replaced the landscapes by ruins by landscapes of an idyllic and pastoral tone, like Francesco Zuccarelli, his master in Venice.
