Description

Briet gasifier siphon, patented by SGDG, Paris. Its invention dates back to 1840. This complete device is in working order. It was used to prepare small quantities of seltzer water or certain carbonated drinks for domestic use. consists of 2 ovoid glass balls wrapped in a reed clissage to protect against shocks and prevent, in the event of an explosion The reed, the projection of shards by the force of the gas. With this large model, it is possible to obtain a liter of seltzer water. But it is now most often used as a curious decorative object. The junction of the 2 balls and the tap are in pewter, the base, the foot is in porcelain.
