

## "daru" Wooden Ladle For Fermented Milk, Flour, Yoghurt And Butter. Nepal



## Description

LADLE "Daru" in blackened wood whose arched handle is animated at its end by a stylized horse's head surmounted by a crescent moon and radiant figure. It was used for transferring fermented milk, flour, yoghurt and butter. Nepal. Wood, H.: 36.5; L.: 10 cm

It retains a trace of red wax, testifying to the customs authorization to leave the country. This system of control of the works was set up in the middle of the 1970s.
